Monday

- Read Romans 1:16 and Acts 14:1-7. How can this story encourage you to be “not ashamed” of Jesus?
- Read Jonah 1-3. How does this story teach the truth: God is at work in your life?

Tuesday

- Read John 20:24-29. How can this story encourage you to follow Jesus, even if you have questions?
- Read John 21:15-19. How does this story teach the truth: Jesus offers forgiveness and purpose?

Heavenly Father, thank you for my camper. Give me peace as you reveal yourself to my camper. Help us both find joy and confidence in you. Amen

Wednesday

- Read Exodus 3:11-12 & 4:10-12. How can this story encourage you to follow Jesus, even if you feel unqualified?
- Read Daniel 1-4, 6. How does this story teach the truth: God is always with you?

Heavenly Father, thank you for the adults who are pouring Jesus into my camper. Help my camper grow from this experience. And refresh me through this change in routine. Amen.

Thursday

- Read Esther 4:11-5:2. How can this story encourage you to follow Jesus, even if you don't understand God's timing?
- Read 2 Timothy 1:6-18. How does this story teach the truth: God leads you to holiness?

Heavenly Father, thank you for my sacred role as a parent. Transform me and my camper for your glory this week. Show us ways to serve you together in the weeks to come. Amen.

Friday

- Read Hebrews 4:16 & Acts 4:31. How does this passage call you to Be Faithful to Jesus?
