SAMPLE AGENDA & MINUTES

In the Trinity Conference, our desire is for each annual Church/Charge Conference to primarily be a worshipful, prayer-filled evaluation and celebration of the ministry in that local church. Church/Charge Conferences are not intended to be drab, boring business meetings to rubber-stamp decisions that have already been made so the paperwork can be forwarded to the Conference Office. Instead, we see the Church/Charge Conference as a way for the church to be accountable to themselves while proclaiming all the amazing things God is doing in their midst!

This Sample Agenda & Minutes may be utilized by Presiding Elders and other Elders designated to facilitate a meeting when planning for Church/Charge Conferences at local churches. Not all churches will have reports for every section, but even if they don't, we still encourage the Presiding Elder or their designee to talk about each section and pray for God to raise up men and women who will be included in that section next year.

- After each report is given, we encourage the participants to ask questions.
- After voting and/or before moving to the next report, we encourage the church to utilize the prayer prompts listed below.
